What is CADEIO?

CADEIO stands for the Catholic Association of Diocesan Ecumenical and Interreligious Officers. It was formerly known as NADEO, the National Association of Diocesan Ecumenical Officers.

Purpose

1. To stimulate an exchange of ideas, experiences and networking among the ecumenical officers of the arch/dioceses in union with Rome.
2. To promote programs that further work of Christian unity and interreligious cooperation.
3. To cooperate with the Bishops/ Committees for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, and with other ecumenical and interreligious agencies.

Government

CADEIO is a voluntary association of ecumenical officers. Our organization is listed in the Official Catholic Directory. The final authority of CADEIO is the General Assembly, which meets at least once a year.

Between meetings of the General Assembly CADEIO is guided by the Board of Directors and the Executive Committee. The Board consists of fifteen members - one elected from each of fourteen geographical regions in the country and one member representing the Eastern Catholic Churches in the United States. The Executive Officers consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, who serve for a term of three years.

There is no paid staff for CADEIO. The Executive Officers and the Board of Directors serve the organization without remuneration.

CADEIO and the Pontifical Council

Full membership in CADEIO is open to ecumenical officers of the (arch)dioceses in union with Rome.

The following persons also qualify:

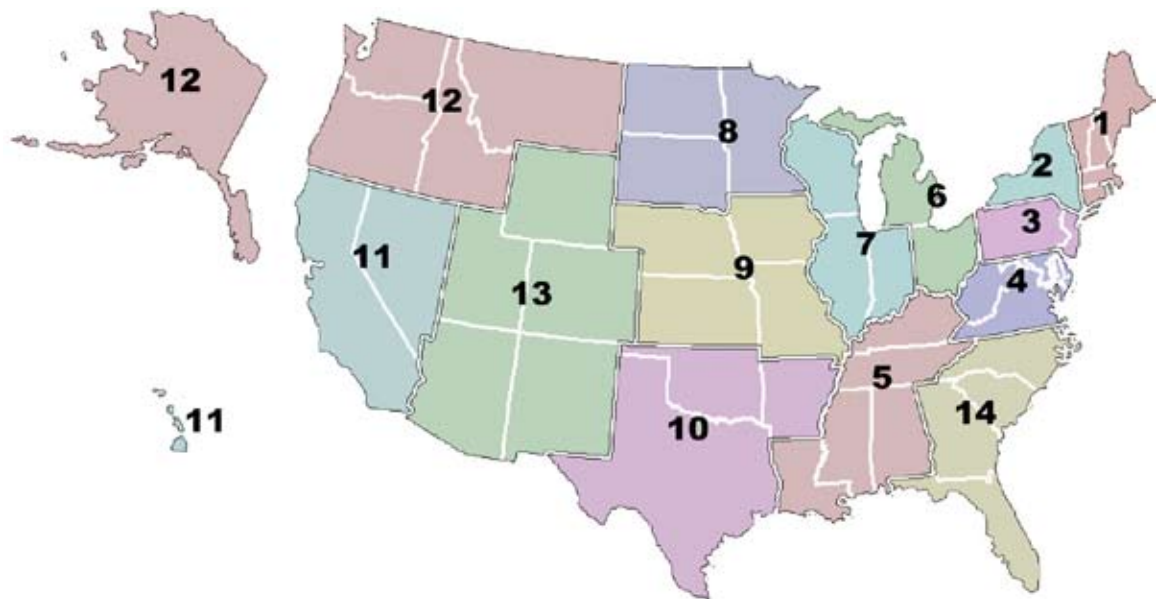
- The chairperson or a member of the diocesan ecumenical commission assigned to represent it;
- One who effectively exercises the role of a diocesan ecumenical officer without an appointment;
- A representative of a religious community that has a special apostolate in ecumenism.

Membership Dues

The membership dues in CADEIO are set each year by the General Assembly. The current annual dues are \$200. Payment of dues is a requirement for membership.

Associate Membership

Associate Membership in CADEIO is open to any person interested in ecumenism, by payment of the yearly associate membership fee - currently \$10. The Associate Member is entitled to receive the CADEIO Newsletter and general announcements via email. The Associate member is entitled to attend the General Assembly with voice but no vote.

Since 1981, the Catholic Association of Diocesan Ecumenical and Interreligious Officers (formerly NADEO) and the Bishops' Committee for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs have sponsored leadership training opportunities beginning with the Introductory Institute for Ecumenical Leadership. Aware of the rapidly changing dimensions of ecumenical work, many wish to have further training to include the latest and most significant changes affecting the work of the officers and commission members.

In response to this need, CADEIO and the BCEIA are once again offering an Advanced Institute for Ecumenical Leadership to be presented from early evening Sunday, July 25, 2010 through midmorning Saturday, July 31. It will be held at the Collegeville Institute for Ecumenical and Cultural Re-

search at Saint John's Abbey and University, Collegeville, Minnesota. The faculty will include Brother Jeffrey Gros, FSC, Rev. Dr. Cecil Robeck, Dr. Michael Root, as well as several monks from Saint John's. The presenters will offer a deeper study of the dialogues and their progress, a closer look at the Eastern Churches, share concerns regarding churches not active in the ecumenical movement, and address other current ecumenical issues.

This opportunity is open to those who have attended the introductory institute or its equivalent. The cost for the six-day program is \$850 per person.
